 dial '999' for all emergency services all '999' calls are free when dialing '999' you will be asked which service you need (police, fire or ambulance) give clear details of the emergency (see details below) do not put the phone down until the control officer clear the line do not move the causality unless it is necessary always give the following information when calling: your name and telephone number exact location of the incident, house number, road number or name, block number and any junctions or other landmarks the type and seriousness of the incident; number, sex and age of the causalities; and anything you know about their condition example: type of accident: household accident number of people injured: one child seriousness of injury: head bleeding
